**DESIGNATE COMPUTER REPAIR TECHNICIAN
TO INTREP SOLUTIONS FROM 2/1/18 TO 1/31/20**

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park (the “Authority”) from time to time requires the services of a qualified computer repair technician to perform as needed computer repair services at the Authority’s public housing sites; and

WHEREAS, the Authority published a notice in the Home News Tribune on 10/1/17 soliciting proposals from qualified contractors through a fair and open process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, the following proposals were received in the Office of the Executive Director until 2:00 PM, Tuesday, October 24, 2017, at which time the proposals were considered in accordance with the evaluation criteria defined in the Specifications with the following evaluation factors:
