**2018 ADOPTED BUDGET RESOLUTION  
HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLAND PARK  
FISCAL YEAR: FROM: 4/1/18 TO: 3/31/19**

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program for the Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park, New Jersey, for the fiscal year beginning April 1, 2018 and ending, March 31, 2019 has been presented for adoption before the governing body of the Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park at its open public meeting of March 14, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Budget and Capital Budget as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services; and

**WHEREAS**, the Annual Budget as presented for adoption reflects Total Revenues of \$2,406,710, Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit, if any, of \$2,421,480 and Total Unrestricted Net Position utilized of \$14,770; and

**WHEREAS**, the Capital Budget as presented for adoption reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$120,503 and Total Unrestricted Net Position planned to be utilized of \$0; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the governing body of the Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park, at an open public meeting held on March 14, 2018 that the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program of the Housing authority of the borough of Highland Park for the fiscal year beginning, April 1, 2018 and, ending, March 31, 2019 is hereby adopted and shall constitute appropriations for the purposes stated; and

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Annual Budget and Capital Budget/Program as presented for adoption reflects each item of revenue and appropriation in the same amount and title as set forth in the introduced and approved budget, including all amendments thereto, if any, which have been approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services.
