

**RESOLUTION #2021-10**  
**DESIGNATE GENERAL COUNSEL FROM APRIL 1, 2021 – MARCH 31, 2023**

**WHEREAS**, the Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park (the “Authority”) needs to retain a Legal Professional to provide Legal Services commencing April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, the Authority published a notice in the Home News Tribune on March 24, 2021 soliciting proposals for professional Legal Services through a fair and open process pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 et seq.; and

**WHEREAS**, the following proposal for Legal Services was received in the Office of the Executive Director until 2:00 PM, April 8, 2021, at which time it was considered in accordance with the Evaluation Process defined in the Specifications:

**WHEREAS**, based upon the quality of the proposal submitted by Breslin & Breslin P.A., in citing the Firm’s extensive team of professionals with relevant experience and expertise in those areas of the law specified by the Authority in its request for proposals that the firm be recommended for retention.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park, New Jersey, that a contract for professional services has been awarded under competitive proposal procurement procedures, as more fully described at 24 CFR 85.36 and PIH Notice 90-47, to the firm of Breslin & Breslin P.A. to provide Legal Services commencing April 1, 2021 through March 31, 2023, for an annual base cost of \$18,420 payable in 24 monthly installments of \$1,535. All such Legal Services to be provided in accordance with the specifications incorporated herein as fully as though set forth at length.
