RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A RENT INCREASE IN THE AMOUNT OF 3% FOR SAMUEL J. KRONMAN BUILDING EFFECTIVE MAY 1, 2022

WHEREAS, on October 4, 2021 the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) released the 2022 Operating Cost Adjustment Factors (OCAFS) for project based rental assistance Programs; and

WHEREAS, the Kronman Affordable Housing GP, the management agent for the Samuel J. Kronman building, has determined that the building is eligible to receive a 3% rent increase effective May 1, 2022 and has submitted the supporting paperwork.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park, New Jersey, hereby approves the request made by the Kronman Affordable Housing GP to increase rents by 3% effective May 1, 2022.
