At this time, Housing Director Sriwardena stated that at least three tenants had COVID that reported it, two of which are hospitalized. Also, access to the community room is limited.

Executive Director Brightman stated that we met today and still have to figure out staffing but all is going well.

Commissioner Rainwater asked when will we announce this information to the tenants.

Executive Director Brightman answered, hopefully, around July 1st. She stated that she needs to know who the replacement is going to be before we do that. She mentioned that Housing Director Sriwardena is leaving in September and that her replacement will start then and the rest of the contract with the WHA will terminate 12/31/23.

Executive Director Brightman stated that she received an email a couple of hours ago and Rita Polos has resigned as she does not feel she can make the meetings.

Communications:

Executive Director Brightman stated that there was no meeting in May for HPAHC or Kronman and that the next one is 6/15/23.

Commissioner Malloy asked if there was any update from PNC.

Executive Director Brightman stated that we have a call scheduled next week.

Commissioner Martinez asked if Bill Katchen was going to be on the call.

Executive Director Brightman stated that she will inform him.

Commissioner Rainwater asked if Trustee Wong should be on the call.

Executive Director Brightman stated that she doesn't think that it is necessary.

Commissioner Martinez asked if there was any flexibility in PNC's guidelines for the release of the 4th payment.

Executive Director responded, no, not at all.

Commissioner Sedehi inquired if the garnish has gone into effect for the Park Terrace tenant.

Counsel Corriston answered, not yet, and that he will follow-up on it.

Section 8 – Executive Director Brightman stated the Section 8 waiting list will be opening for Highland Park residents only (live or work.) We are only accepting 150 applications

Housing Director Sriwardena stated that rent collection is good: 99% at Kronman and 94% at Park Terrace.

Executive Director Brightman stated that we are still having a hard time leasing Section 8 units due to the high rents. The other two impediments are that management companies do credit checks, and not all low-income people have good credit scores. There are two laws pending, one that would eliminate credit checks in this type of circumstance and other defining how criminal background checks should be interpreted.

Commissioner Martinez stated that she would check on the progress of the laws.

Commissioner Rainwater stated that we still do not have closure on Commissioner Chonoles and that he will send her an email.

Executive Director Brightman stated that she sent Commissioner Rainwater the list of contractors that he requested.

Commissioner Sedehi asked why did the elevator take five weeks to repair.

Housing Director Sriwardena stated that the company could not get the parts and that it's working fine now.
