REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR COMPUTER AND CYBER SECURITY MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR THE BOROUGH OF HIGHLAND PARK HOUSING AUTHORITY

The Housing Authority of the Borough of Highland Park, New Jersey (hereinafter referred to as the "Authority"), is soliciting proposals from qualified firms to provide Computer and Cyber Security Maintenance Services for a two-year term beginning November 17, 2025, and ending December 1, 2027.

The Authority seeks an experienced computer and cybersecurity consulting firm to monitor, maintain, and safeguard its technology systems, ensuring reliable operations and minimal service interruptions. The Authority currently operates nine (9) computer workstations connected to a central server located at the Samuel Kronman Building main office. The server is more than two years old, and the workstations range in age from ten years to as recent as 2024.

Computers are used throughout the **Kronman Samuel Building** property by a staff of seven (7) end-users. The Authority utilizes PHA-Web Software as its housing management platform, which supports data management for approximately 124 project-based units and 220+ Section 8 vouchers.

The contract for services will specifically include the following:

Scope of Services

The selected contractor will provide comprehensive computer maintenance and cybersecurity services, including but not limited to:

- 1. Conducting a full assessment of the current computer system and recommending improvements.
- 2. Developing and implementing a reliable system backup protocol.
- 3. Preparing a usage manual in coordination with Authority staff.
- 4. Tracking, diagnosing, and resolving daily technical issues.
- 5. Coordinating with PHA-Web Software and other relevant vendors as needed.
- 6. Installing and managing system and software updates.
- 7. Ensuring compliance with cybersecurity regulations and policies as required by the New Jersey Joint Insurance Fund (JIF).
- 8. Conducting quarterly onsite reviews with Authority staff to ensure cybersecurity measures are maintained and optimized.

All services required for Computer and Cyber Security Maintenance can be requested by emailing <u>Dsblake@hphousing.org</u>. Proposals must be submitted by 11:00 a.m. on Thursday, November 13, 2025 at the Authority offices located at 242 S. 6th Avenue, Highland Park, New Jersey. Offerors are required to comply with NJAC 17:27. The Authority reserves the right to reject any and all proposals.
